Zoom® Telephonics Begins Volume Shipments of New Low-cost Wireless-N Router

Model 4402 Adds to Zoom's Growing Line of Wireless-N Routers and Adapters

Boston, Massachusetts, August 5, 2010-- Zoom Telephonics, Inc. (OTCBB: ZMTP) announced today the first volume shipments of the Zoom Model 4402 Wireless-N Router. The low-cost Model 4402 connects to an ADSL modem or cable modem to provide shared Internet access to computers, phones, game stations, and other devices via its wireless capability and/or its four Ethernet LAN ports. It can also function as a wireless access point, or as a wireless Repeater that extends the range of a wireless network.

At an estimated retail price of only \$39, Model 4402 is an excellent choice for a home or small business. Zoom's new Wireless-N Router supports wireless data speeds up to 150 Mbps, a wireless range up to 1000 feet (304 meters), and up to 253 users. Features include support for all popular forms of wireless security, Wi-Fi Protected Setup to ease installation, a robust firewall, and local or remote configuration using an Internet browser. Model 4402 has a detachable external antenna to allow easy attachment of a special purpose antenna for extraordinary situations where a longer range or directional antenna is required.

Model 4402 is a flexible networking tool that can be configured as either a router, a wireless-N access point, or as a wireless-n repeater to extend the reach of a network. It works with 802.11 n, g, b, and mixed wireless networks; and supports wireless speeds up to 150 Mbps.

Model 4402 joins a growing line of Zoom products supporting the 802.11n wireless networking protocol. That line includes low-cost USB adapters, desktop routers that can be connected to either a wired broadband connection or a 3G cellular USB modem, and a 3G mobile router that can operate on either batteries or AC power.

"Model 4402 is a great value, and an important addition to our broad line of wireless-N products," said Frank Manning, President and CEO of Zoom Telephonics.
